What's ransomware? It's data kidnapping.

It's a form of malware that hackers use to target both individual and organizational networks to deny the availability of important information and systems.

It's often delivered through phishing, or fraudulent, emails.

When a computer or device is affected by ransomware, its data, files, folders or systems may become unavailable. In exchange for supposedly offering the user access to their data again, the hacker demands the payment of a ransom.
